KOZ GREENHORN

A kid who just entered the KOZ Program has work to do. They may be skilled in outdoor activities, they may know bible scripture, but they must work to gain their rewards in KOZ. To become a KOZ Greenhorn they must:

(all ages)

- Make six consecutive meetings. (Makeup meetings can be used if approved by HTL Only)
- Memorize KOZ Prayer
- Memorize one scripture or verse. (Their choice, a life verse.)
- Meet with at least one HTL for endorsement.

Once these tasks have been completed the Greenhorn receives their KOZ Dog Tag designating them a Greenhorn. The Greenhorn KOZ in many ways is the most important KOZ kid because they are learning a new way.

KOZ LEADERSHIP PATH

KOZ COYOTE

(all ages)

To be a COYOTE a kid must complete the below tasks:

- Attend KOZ Monthly meetings with a minimum of one year of meetings. (Makeup meetings can be used if approved by HTL Only)
- Memorize KOZ Prayer
- Memorize two scriptures or verses. (Their choice)
- Tell their HTL about their favorite book in the bible.
- Must earn/pass and carry current Hunters Safety.
- Have a hunting and fishing license in the state where they attend KOZ
- Have been on at least three overnight KOZ outings.
- Must be passing in school.
- Meet with at least one HTL for endorsement.
- Create and/or perform in a mission trip. (may participate in a structured outreach by qualified organization)

Once these tasks have been completed the Greenhorn receives their Coyote KOZ Dog Tag designating them a Coyote. The Coyote has begun an important step toward leadership in KOZ.

KOZ LEADERSHIP PATH

KOZ L.I.T.

(13 years and up)

Leader in Training (LIT) a kid must complete the Greenhorn and Coyote level tasks then the below tasks:

- Memorize KOZ Prayer
- Memorize two scriptures or verses. (Their choice)
- Tell their HTL about their favorite book in the bible.
- Must earn/pass and carry current Hunters Safety.
- Have a hunting and fishing license in the state where they attend KOZ.
- Must be passing in school
- Attend church regularly.
- Participate in at least six camps or outings as an LIT.
- Be in a regular study with an HTL, Mentor/ Youth group
- Meet with at least one HTL for endorsement.
- Read "Wild at Heart"
- Read "Every Young Mans Battle" - both books can be read and worked with HTL or other leader to account for regular bible study.
- Attend another mission trip.
- Participate in a Christian Summer Camp
- Volunteer at church

KOZ LEADERSHIP PATH

KOZ HTL

(17 years and up)

To be a Harvest Team Leader (HTL) you must complete the Greenhorn, Coyote and LIT level tasks then the below tasks:

- HTL's will be training in the skills to lead a KOZ group, teach at KOZ hunting and fishing outings and train others. This leadership position can only be designated by KOZ National leadership.
- An adult HTL leader must complete KOZ HTL training manual with an approved trainer to become an HTL.
- It is recommended that HTL's work backwards to be able to share the leadership experience with the boys who are working through it.
- They must also be participating in a church family. Not necessarily the hosting church, but they must be part of a church.

KOZ LEADERSHIP PATH

KOZ OUTFITTER

(21 years and up)

KOZ Outfitter: A KOZ Outfitter is the top certification in KOZ.

- An outfitter has completed all requirements and can lead individual outings and events.
- They lead or participate in a regular KOZ meeting at their church or another for a minimum of one year.
- The designation includes completion of Huntmaster Training through Parks and Wildlife.
- Red Cross First Aid.
- KOZ mentor training weekend. (Contact KOZ National Headquarters)
- Participated in leading a minimum of six camps (3 days or more).
- Personally involved with mentoring KOZ kids.
- Willing to train other HTL's in other churches as available.
