KOZ Harvest Team Leader (HTL) FACILITATOR Online Training Guide Before You Start

Welcome to the adventure of the KOZ Harvest Team Leader Training.

If you are reading this then you are planning a Kids Outdoor Zone Harvest Team Leader training at your church.

Through this training time there will be specific elements you need to make sure are included. This training is designed to inspire and train the men in your group. It is an anointed training that must be followed closely to reach the desired effects, the transfer of the KOZ DNA.

First and foremost take time to pray over every element of the training. Pray before you announce it. Pray as you hand out flyers. Pray for the men who may encounter warfare from the evil one trying to keep them away. Pray you are focused and present in your heart and mind during this training.

Timeline: Wives meal. A nice meal with the men and their wives to inform her about KOZ and how important she is to the success of the ministry. This is usually done best when it is a Friday evening. Approximately 1.5 hrs.

KOZ HTL Training starts: Men begin training. This is usually best to do on a Saturday morning. 8am - 3pm, approximately 6 hrs. Training concludes and men are certified as Harvest Team Leaders (HTLs) in Kids Outdoor Zone.

There are a few things that will make this training its best.

High-end video and audio gear. A large screen for the video and good sound equipment is imperative. Because of the nature of this training and the video and audio elements it will be hard for the men to concentrate and stay focused if it is not done well. This is critical.

The training manual. Make sure each man training has a manual. Supply them with a good working pen to do the work pages. Stop the video at the work pages and encourage and help them complete each section. This helps them retain the critical pieces they need to know.

Tables are best. Long tables where the guys can spread out is usually best. They can easily fill in the workspace with their water bottle or coffee next to them.

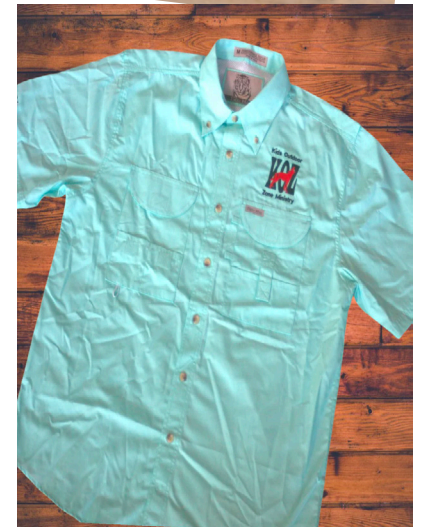
Water and food. Most trainings include at least one meal time, some more. Making water and coffee available is great. Food should be quick and simple. Too much time away from the training and too much food can take the air out of the men and they can become tired and listless. Probably not donuts, pizza, or heavy foods.

Breaks should be short and sweet. Again, the men need to stay focused and they lose that if they have too much time away. Talk quickly switches to the game last night or the deer stand or lawn mower.

LEADER TAG & GEAR! After your men train you will be honoring them with their KOZ HTL Dog Tag. There are KOZ leader caps, shirts and more you may want in advance of your training. Buy online or call the office 512-292-1113.

Send in the group picture. Include flag!

All the signed HTL registration forms go through the online registration. It must be completed by each man trained (only ones who completed the full training) and sent to KOZ World Ranch Headquarters to receive their official *KOZ HTL Certificate*.

The KOZ Wives Dinner Event

This is a crucial element to the training. It must be a part of your overall planning. We have seen without exception that the groups that have engaged the wives in the mission have far more success than those who have not.

SETTING UP - The “Letter to the Wives” training takes about 1.5 – 2 hours max.

Set a date and time. Friday nights are good prior to your Saturday HTL training for the men. These can be done over two week nights or one full day on Saturday or Sunday. **Maximize the Effect:** However, we have found that the time and effect is maximized if done with a Friday Night Wives Dinner then HTL Training on Saturday separate from the wives event works best.

Plan a meal. Pot luck is fine but may be best if the wives are blessed with a dinner the men plan. There are always the amazing ladies who want to plan and execute the night. Let them-they are a blessing-but help make it nice. Decor, flowers, tablecloths. This is date night level, take it seriously.

You need top quality audio and video equipment for both trainings. The bigger the screen the better. The better the sound system the more impact all trainings will have. It is imperative to have all this working in advance. This cannot be emphasized enough - bigger is better in this case.

No children. This is a time to train. Focus and attention is critical. No kids or cleaning of the kitchen during the trainings. These can be huge distractions and take away from the message. Keep distractions to a minimum. This is very important. These suggestions are more than ideas; we know that they make a difference.

Ask everyone to turn off cell phones. Start on time.

As the meal is coming to a close begin the program.

Begin: Introduce yourself and your wife – have all others introduce themselves.

- **Talk about the program and how it was brought to the church.** Talk about how the idea of KOZ got to this point with you and your church.
- **Explain that in any ministry** when the husband and wife do not support the others ministry work, many times their efforts fail. The program of KOZ recognizes the absolute need of the wife/girlfriend to support their husbands and the work ahead in rescuing the fatherless boys.
- **Explain the video** they are about to watch: *TJ Greaney, founder of Kids Outdoor Zone (KOZ), shares the story and mission of KOZ. His wife Sandra reads the letter TJ wrote in the manual to the wives of the men stepping into KOZ. This is the story of KOZ and why the wives are so important.*

After the Videos

- **Play these two videos back to back.**
- **After the video explain** to the wives that, again, this ministry is only as strong as the men and women doing it. The wives are truly the backbone of the program. They can be their husband's biggest cheerleader. Satan knows that if he can divide the husband and wife, he can break the ministry efforts.
- **Also explain to the training wives that** there will be new HTL wives as more men train and our prayer is that they would take this "Letter to the Wives" training and be with them, invite them in, love on them. We never want a man to step into KOZ without the support of his wife and existing KOZ wives can help here.
- Give them their copy of the personal letter from Sandra Greaney, KOZ Founder TJ Greaney's wife.

Have a Question and Answer session at the end.

FINAL ELEMENTS

After the wives have trained make sure their husbands have their email and cell phone number so he can register them as "Trained" when he completes his training. This is a critical element and only then will they receive the FREE KOZ WIVES T-shirt.

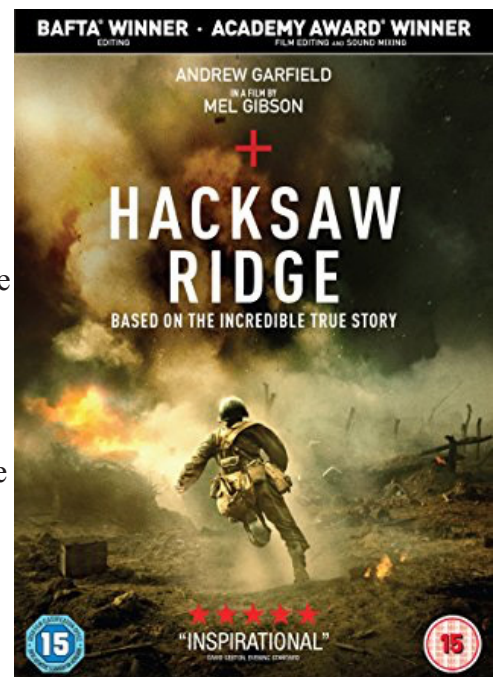
Video #3: Hacksaw Ridge

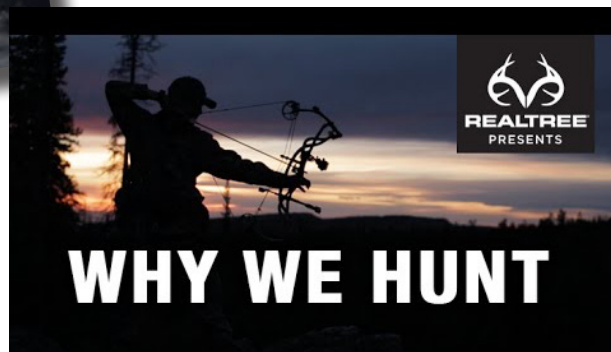
